



CONSULATE GENERAL OF GRENADA

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROCESSING PRE-CLEARANCE LETTER FOR APPLICANTS OF COUNTRIES WHO RECEIVE VISAS AT PORT-OF-ENTRY IN GRENADA

1. Application **MUST** be completed in **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink.
2. It is advised that applications be made at least **eight (8) weeks PRIOR** to departure date. The processing time for the application is approximately **twenty (20) business days** from date of receipt.
3. Applicant's passport **MUST** be valid for at least six (6) months from date of departure from Grenada and accompany application.
4. Only a **FULLY COMPLETED** Visa Application Form will be accepted.
5. TWO (2) Passport pictures (*no more than 3 months old*), one certified by a Justice of the Peace or a Notary Public on the Photo Authentication Form and one adhered to the visa application form.
6. U. S. Permanent Residents who require a visa to visit Grenada **must** also show proof of permission to re-enter the U.S. (*Please bring your Residency Card with you to Embassy or if mailing, photocopy both sides of your card on one page and have it notarized*).
7. The fee for a **Pre-Clearance Letter** is **US\$10.00** payable to Embassy of Grenada.
8. In order to forward the Pre-Clearance Letter to you, please include a separate money order for **US\$20.00** for **Express Service** (*mailing within USA mainland*), or **US\$60.00** for **Express International Service** (*mailing outside USA mainland*). Certified bank cheque(s) or money order(s) are payable to **Embassy of Grenada**. **ONLY CERTIFIED CHEQUES OR MONEY ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED. CASH** accepted **IN-PERSON ONLY**.
9. Please forward the following to receive the Pre-Clearance letter to facilitate your travel to Grenada:
 - i. Completed Visa Application, signed and one photo (*no more than three (3) months old*), adhered to application where indicated, **and**
 - ii. Passport valid for at least six (6) months from date of departure from Grenada, **and**
 - iii. Second passport pictures (*no more than three (3) months old*), certified by a Justice of the Peace or a Notary Public (*on the Photo Authentication Form included*), **and**
 - iv. Coloured copy of the data page of your passport, **and**
 - v. Confirmation of accommodations while in Grenada, **and**
 - vi. If you are a Permanent Resident of the US, notarized copy of your Residency Card – see No. 6 above, **and**
 - vii. One money order for the Pre-Clearance letter fee and if applicable, a separate money order for the return courier fee.
10. Upon arrival in Grenada the fee for a Single-Entry visa is **EC\$100.00 (~US\$40)** per applicant and the fee for a Multiple-Entry visa is **EC\$250.00 (~US\$100)** per applicant.
11. Visas are valid for only the period of time specified.
12. Holders of Visas may not work in Grenada unless authorized to do so by the local Ministry of Labour.




